Applicants must meet the following qualifications:

- Must be a resident of the United States,
- Must have achieved a "B" average to apply for and receive scholarship funds,
- Must have been a senior in high school when completing project,
- Must enter at least one (1) category and must have made the item entered,
- Must submit an official transcript from the school attended in May of the same year the project was made, (School may mail the transcript to 218 W. 46th Street - Odessa, TX 79762
- Must turn in a complete application,
- Must submit a certified drug test one month prior to scholarship funds being sent to the Financial Aid Officer of the recipient's chosen accredited college, university or technical school.

Scholarship funds may only be used for tuition, books, and fees at an accredited college, university, or technical school. The recipient must notify the PBF&E Scholarship Board of the college, university, or technical school of his/her choice. Scholarship funds will be submitted directly to the college, university, or technical school on behalf of the recipient. The recipient has five (5) years from the date of the Fair in which the scholarship was awarded to utilize the scholarship funds. After five (5) years, the funds will be un-obligated. Young people related to PBF&E Board members, Fair employees or Fair judges by blood or marriage to and including fourth generation are not eligible for scholarship consideration.
